Weather

- Expect highly variable mountain weather
- Expect a mix of sun and rain
- Temperature will decrease with higher elevation
- Rain gear is ESSENTIAL
- Layering is ESSENTIAL

Adults

- Must be registered Boy Scout Leaders
- Must complete Youth Protection Training

Health and Safety Details

- Passports
 - Scouts will be responsible for their own passport during the trips
 - 2 Adults will carry forms and copies of passports
- Medications
 - Must be in original containers
 - If listed on Physical Form, they must be brought on trip

Money Details

- Adults will carry money on a need based system
 - Cash for each meal will be carried by separate adults
 - Cash for lodging will be carried by separate adults
 - Kandersteg camp costs will be billed to troop at departure
- Scouts are responsible for their own souvenir money
